

JONATHAN SCOTT

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Scott was born in Dallas, Texas. He attended David W. Carter High School in Dallas, where he was a three-sport athlete. While in high school, Scott played in the first-ever U.S. Army All-American Bowl on December 30, 2000.



Jonathan played college football for the University of Texas, and was recognized as a unanimous All-American. Following his senior season in 2005, he was a first-team All-Big 12 selection again, and was recognized as a unanimous first-team All-American. Scott was a member of the 2005 Longhorns team that defeated the USC Trojans 41-38 in the Rose Bowl to win the BCS National Championship. He was drafted by the Detroit Lions in the fifth round of the 2006 NFL Draft, and has also played for the Buffalo Bills and Pittsburgh Steelers.

Jonathan brings the knowledge and technique necessary to train offensive lineman. His techniques helped 3 Offensive Lineman from 2018's APEC NFL class to make NFL Rosters as "long shots". He combines film, footwork, and also educates his athletes on how to become a true professional on and off the field.
